


Progress Book

(Accessing your child's grades & homework online)

- Log in to the Bluffton School website: www.bluffton.noacsc.org
- Under “Parents and Community” on the right hand side of the screen, click on the box “Progress Book” The logo for Progress Book by Software Partners, Inc. features a red house icon on the left, the text "ProgressBook" in a stylized font in the center, and a blue house icon on the right.
- The “Progress book” webpage will pop up. In the upper right hand corner it will say “login”. Click on this and a box will pop up and ask you for your “username” and “password”. The username and password are case sensitive so it has to be typed in exactly how it was originally assigned. If you do not know this information, contact the office and Julie Oberly will assign them for you,
- After you have entered your username and password, click on “login” and the progress book page will pop back up. Under STUDENT, click on “Averages”. This will pop up the current grades of your child. Click on the actual course name to see the list of assignments and the grades earned on them.
- To view homework assignments, click on “Classroom” and then homework.

Both you and your child have your own separate username and password. This allows each of you to view the account individually. Please call the office if you have any questions in accessing your child's account.
